Dear Preparatory String Orchestra members and families:

On behalf of the New England Conservatory Preparatory School, I'd like to extend a warm welcome to you as a member of NEC's Preparatory String Orchestra, Adam Grossman, conductor. We are delighted to have both new and returning members with us for the 2007-08 season.

In this mailing you will find important information about rehearsal and performance dates, the attendance policy, registration, and seating auditions. We have also included a preliminary roster for carpool purposes. The final roster and ensemble handbook will be distributed in late September or early October.

Please note that all members of PSO must register for the Fall 2007 semester prior to the first PSO rehearsal on September 15. The tuition for the year is \$600 (\$425 for students taking at least 12 private lessons/semester through NEC). New students must register in person between September 4 and September 15. Students who were enrolled at NEC previously will receive a mail-in registration form in about 10 days, and may register by mail, fax, or in-person.

All PSO members, new or returning, must sign up for a seating audition. Sign-ups begin online at necprepauditions.com on August 15. Auditions will take place Saturday and Sunday, September 8 and 9. Students should prepare two contrasting solo pieces for the audition.
